

Places of Interest

Day 2 Okayama



Visit Okayama Korakuen Garden, which still retains traces of the Edo period. It was built by Tsunamasa Ikeda, the second feudal lord of the Okayama domain.



Okayama Korakuen Garden

- Visit Enyo-tei House...The building provides an expansive view of areas inside and outside the garden
- Visit the Noh Stage
- Stroll inside Okayama Korakuen Garden

Day 3 Unnan / Matsue



Travel around Unnan, which is home to the traditional Japanese ironmaking process of Tatara ironworks and associated with the Yamata no Orochi legend; and visit Matsue where the tea ceremony culture lives on.



Izumo Kagura

- Visit Sugaya Tatara Sannai

...This district has Japan's last original iron smelting furnace for Tatara ironworks
- Visit the Tanabe Home/Storehouses

...The distinguished family was widely known as one of the most prominent owners of forestland in Japan
- View Izumo Kagura, a traditional performing art, at Kagura no Yado
- Visit Meimei-an Tea House and enjoy green tea

...This tea house is associated with Fumai Matsudaira, a well-known feudal lord and master of tea ceremony



The open kitchen lets you experience the live atmosphere of onboard cooking and enjoy culinary masterpieces while taking in the beautiful scenery through the large windows.

► Lounge Car [Car No.5]

SALON DE L'OUEST

The lounge car, adorned with a bar counter, tea tables for ryurei (a style of a tea ceremony performed while sitting on a chair), and a boutique space, allows you to savor the hospitality of MIZUKAZE in a tranquil space filled with wood accents.

► Observation Car [Car No.1 and 10]

Revel in the magnificent scenery and even starry skies from the spacious observation room, which offers expansive panoramas, and step out onto the observation deck to feel the breeze.

The doors are crafted from wood sourced from five prefectures in the Chugoku region, and traditional crafts from along the route have been incorporated into the design of the cars.


